The B.A. minor in Gender Studies is divided into six modules. Each module concludes with a module examination (proof of achievement). The module exams can be completed in the form of a written exam (120 minutes) or a term paper. Oral exams, presentations, etc., are not permissible forms of assessment under Examination Regulations (PO) 2015, though oral exams are permitted under PO 2022
